REGARDING THE RESPONSE TO THE SUPPLIER'S REQUEST

We hereby inform you that the public procurement commission of UAB "Vilniaus viešasis transportas" (hereinafter – the Contracting Entity), while conducting the procurement of Technical Assistance Vehicles (Tow Trucks) No. 2 through an open tender (procurement No. 2676426), received a request from one of the suppliers on 2025-05-28 via the CVP IS communication tool to clarify the procurement documents.

The Contracting Entity provides the following response to the supplier's request:

| 1. | <p>Please clarify what is the proper type of towing device shall be supplied for attachment to the main lifting/towing arm?</p> <p>1. As per Section 22.2. of the Technical Specification the "Fork" (šakė) type towing device shall be supplied. According to the usual practice the fork type towing device is not suitable for towing of the public transport vehicles (buses or trolleybuses). Usually Fork is used for towing of trucks (lorries) holding them from the wheel axle. The Fork could be useful on public transport vehicles only if wheels are missing or completely damaged. Please see picture 1 attached.</p> <p>2. For the towing of public transport vehicles from the front or rear wheels it is common to use "Glasses" (akiniai) sometimes also called "Wheel Grids". Please see Picture 2 attached.</p> <p>We recommend to clarify this question officially for all potential bidders to avoid any misunderstanding.</p> <p>Please feel free to use attached pictures and used definitions for the changes in the Technical Specification if needed.</p> | <p>We clarify that clause 22.2 of Annex 1 "Technical Specification" of the procurement conditions, which specifies the vehicle towing method as "Special support device (fork) for transporting buses by lifting the front or rear axle", means that the vehicles must be towed by lifting the front or rear axle by the wheels, not by the axle itself. Therefore, the type of support device described as a "fork" in the mentioned clause should be interpreted as the type "glasses". This is visually illustrated in the sketch provided in clause 23.6 of Annex 1 "Technical Specification" of the procurement conditions.</p> |
